We are a cooperative founded in 2003 by a group of 21 producers from the Vila Céu do Mapiá community, founded in 1983. This community is located at the headwaters of the Mapiá creek, 30 km from the Purus River, in one of the most unspoiled areas of the western Brazilian Amazon.



Since then, Cooperar has sought to expand its range of activities, encouraging multiple use of the forest in its production centers. With great social and environmental responsibility aimed at keeping the forest standing, today we work with the involvement of 65 riverside communities along more than 1000 km of

From these 65 communities, we have strategically structured 8 production centers: 5 for processing native cocoa, 1 for processing tropical wood, 1 for a model of good practices for collecting and pre-treating oilseeds. In order to add value and develop quality products, we have an agro-industry at

our branch in the municipality of Boca do Acre/AM, with the capacity to extract vegetable oils and butters, produce pastes, flours, dehydrated fruit and cocoa nibs.
