Collected from rational hives and managed in a totally sustainable way, Oxente Honey preserves its origin and ensures a production process that respects the environment and contributes to the continuity of the species. Its composition maintains important natural properties, such as antioxidants and bioactive compounds, resulting in a nutritious, authentic and high-quality food.

More than just a honey, Mel Oxente represents a direct link to Brazilian biodiversity and the culture of the northeast. Each pot carries the appreciation of native pollinators, the strengthening of family farming and support for communities that work in a responsible and environmentally conscious way. ### **DETAILS ON PRODUCTION CAPACITY, SEASONALITY AND OTHER CHARACTERISTICS:**



**Current production capacity is 2,000 liters per year, the result of two annual harvests of approximately 1,000 liters each, which allows us to fully respect the ripening time needed to guarantee the ideal quality of the honey at the time of bottling.**
