Our operation is conducted in accordance with key international protocols, reinforcing our commitment to high standards of quality, traceability, and food safety at every stage of the process.

Flores Citrus is located in one of the most suitable regions in Brazil for citrus farming. The cultivation takes place in the Lower Açú Irrigation District, known for its combination of semi-arid climate, high solar incidence throughout the year, and low relative humidity, conditions that favor the development of fruits with excellent color, firm skin, and high visual appeal. The water availability from the Açú Valley irrigation system allows for precise water and nutrient management, ensuring stable production and consistent quality. This combination of factors, along with technically sound agricultural practices, results in Tahiti limes with excellent structure, high post-harvest durability, and attributes highly valued by the most demanding markets.

Furthermore, Flores Citrus has a strategic location that enhances logistical efficiency and the distribution of its produce. The region has easy access to the main highway corridors of the Northeast, allowing for quick connections to important export points, such as the ports of Pecém, Natal, and Mucuripe. Added to this is the proximity to Fortaleza International Airport – Pinto Martins, expanding the possibilities for efficient and competitive logistics operations and international transport.

The production operation is structured around approximately **50 hectares** of Tahiti lime cultivation, with about **24,000 plants** grown under specialized technical management.
