NCM 2096.90.00 Concentrated grape juice 68°Brix

Produced through grapes of several varieties and typical of the mountain region of Rio Grande do Sul, obtained through healthy, fresh and ripe fruits.

NCM 2096.970.00 Concentrated apple juice 70°Brix

Produced through grapes of several varieties and typical of the mountain region of Rio Grande do Sul, obtained through healthy, fresh and ripe fruits.

NCM 2009.61.00 Grape Juice 100%

Produced through diluted concentrated juice of red grapes, it has purplish coloring. It has a soft aroma and taste, with sweet fruity notes.

DETAILS ON PRODUCTION CAPACITY, SEASONALITY AND OTHER CHARACTERISTICS:



Installed production capacity for 50,000,000 (million) of fruit per year and storage for 12,500 tons of concentrated juice.

Grape harvest: takes place from January to March.

Apple harvest: takes place from February to May orchard fruit and the rest of the year we receive fruit from packing house.
