We produce special and specialty coffees. Coffees with micro,

nano and single lots. The UNIQUE lots are exotic lots where the buyer can follow the entire process, from processing, harvesting, drying, roasting and packaging, creating a coffee produced exclusively for each customer.

The estate is implementing camera systems where the buyer can follow the stages of production.

The property is in the process of being certified (CERTIFICA MINAS) with the support of EMATER-MG, Caratinga, in 2024.

We are part of the Association of Specialty Coffee Producers of the Caratinga Highlands, which is seeking a Designation of Origin (DO).
