Urubatan Piatã is a Brazilian company operating in Rio de Janeiro and Amapá, recognized as one of the few in the country to successfully export Brazil nuts to Europe and the United States. We operate in the natural products market, focusing on Brazil nuts, widely appreciated for their flavor, nutritional value, and multiple applications in the food industry, both for fresh consumption and as an ingredient in prepared products.



Our operations value sustainable extraction and strengthen Amazonian communities through the Castanheir@s Program, which involves approximately 4,500 extractivists in an area of 600,000 hectares of preserved forest. With this direct production chain from the forest to the international market, each batch sold contributes to local income generation and the conservation of the Amazon.

## PRODUCTS



### Brazil nuts in shell (NCM 0801.22.00)

Product obtained from raw Brazil nuts, subjected to a drying process to ensure better preservation. After drying, the fruits are sorted by size and packed in 25 kg jute sacks.

### Shelled Brazil nuts (NCM 0801.21.00)

Raw Brazil nuts undergo drying, sorting, shelling, and dehydration. They are then vacuum-packed and packed in 20 kg cardboard boxes.

Brazil nuts are a fruit exclusive to the Amazon Rainforest and are recognized worldwide as one of the richest sources of selenium for human consumption, an essential mineral for the immune system, hormonal balance, and disease prevention. They have high nutritional value, containing approximately 60–70% lipids, 15–20% protein, as well as fiber and essential amino acids such as methionine. They are also rich in magnesium, phosphorus, vitamin E, calcium, iron, potassium, zinc, and copper, making them a functional food of high nutritional value.

Beyond its health benefits, the Brazil nut production chain is one of the most important sustainable economies in the Amazon. Each batch sold directly supports extractivists and contributes to forest conservation through the Castanheir@s Program, making importers and partners active agents in the socio-environmental development of the region.
