The enterprise is located in Albertina, in the south of Minas Gerais, on the São João Batista site, occupying a total production area of 20 hectares, where manual labor is predominant. Production began in 1940, by producer Leandro Rinco, father of the current owner, Andalicio Donizetti Rinco, where he was born, grew up and raised his family, and currently continues to work with his wife Marcia and their three children.



The name "carrocero" came from the fact that the first owner used a cart, pulled by animals, to move the coffee from the countryside to the urban center, bringing back the supplies for his family and neighbors, known as Leandro Carrocero.
