Casa Moura Winery is located in the Serra da Jiboa – GO, Brazil, between 960 and 1,080 meters above sea level, with a wide temperature range, a semi-humid tropical microclimate, and soil composed of sandstone, quartzite, and schist rocks.



The productivity of Casa Moura Winery per hectare is limited, which is a key factor in ensuring the high concentration and quality of the wines. Planting occurs in small plots, with cultivation practices including double pruning and manual winter harvesting, with active vines seeking nutrients deep within the rocks. The terroir thrives in a sustainable environment, alongside 1,200 hectares of native Cerrado forest preserved by the winery, which uses lightweight bottles, utilizes energy from renewable sources, and practices conscious water consumption to reduce carbon emissions.

Our winery has a production capacity of up to 33,000 bottles per year, with wines produced in the Serra da Jiboa region of Goiás. The product is available throughout all months of the year, with an annual harvest.

Our high-end wines are aromatic, balanced, with aging potential, vegan, unfiltered, not aged in wood, and without air exchange—all to preserve the natural flavors and aromas of the grape. They are full-bodied with greater intensity on the palate, featuring a complex and surprisingly layered sensory profile, with typicity that stands out from the standards, and greater expression of the grape varieties.

Casa Moura product lines:


W One: Dry red wines with an alcohol content between 13% and 14%.

Cerrado Highlands: Dry red wines with an alcohol content between 14.1% and 16%. Dry white wines with an alcohol content between 11% and 12%.

Serra da Jiboa: Dry red wines from early harvests, lighter, gastronomic and everyday. Alcohol content between 12% and 13%.

Ercídia: Sweet and semi-sweet liqueurs. Late harvest wine, without the addition of grape brandy. Alcohol content between 17% and 18%. Elegant, versatile, perfect for appetizers, desserts, and drinks.

The W One and Terras Altas do Cerrado red wines have already received 10 medals – double gold, gold and silver – in national and international competitions, such as Viniales (Cannes), IWC (London), Vinus (Mendoza) and GPVB (Rio de Janeiro). Casa Moura Winery participates exclusively in blind tastings at 15 of the world's most prestigious wine competitions.



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
