In 1878, João Manoel Franco planted his first coffee trees on the Pinhal do Campestre farm, one of the pioneers in establishing the crop, which had just arrived in southern Minas Gerais, today the world's largest producing region.



Favored by the climate, altitude, and volcanic soils, crops developed well and became the farm's main activity.

Today, our Sítio Belém, a remnant of this farm, is the fifth generation producing some of the best coffee in Brazil.

The 1878 is a special coffee, produced at an altitude of 1200 meters, which makes it an excellent drink, with balanced notes of sweetness, body, and acidity and distinctive nuances of chocolate, toasted caramel, almonds, red fruits, and others, achieving ratings above

85 points.

The 1878 specialty coffee can be purchased in 500-gram and 250-gram packages, roasted in beans or ground, or raw, in 30-kilo packages.
