Peeled Brazil nuts (almond) and Chestnut oil

Almond: in bulk - 20kg boxes with vacuum packed aluminized bag;

For retail - 250g pots or pouches;

Oil: in bulk - 20L oil bottle

For retail: 250ml bottle

It serves the cosmetic industry (e.g. Natura) and major retailers (e.g. Carrefour) and exports since 2020

Fairtrade FLO certification in progress.

Sustainable extraction of native forest; long-term partnerships with Indigenous communities under fair trade conditions: differentiated and early payment to finance collectors, conducts training and provides work material for collection.
