Fresh onions produced in the Southern Coast of Brazil, a region that gives the product differentiated organoleptic characteristics and a strong territorial identity. Predominantly cultivated by family farmers, the production values the use of family labor and the maintenance of traditional practices, with a low level of mechanization and special attention to the different stages of cultivation and harvesting.

The product stands out for its quality and characteristics of flavor, aroma, color, and texture, which reflect the soil, climate, and management conditions of the producing region. This territorial identity represents an important competitive advantage, especially in markets that value the origin, quality, and authenticity of food.

The production shows potential for greater standardization, traceability, and value addition, allowing for the strengthening of origin identification and increasing buyer confidence. With a focus on quality, consistency, and valuing the territory, onions from the Southern Coast have the potential for insertion and expansion in both domestic and international markets, also contributing to the strengthening of family farming and the regional production chain.

Processing capacity of up to 1,500 bags per day (30 tons), with variations depending on the harvest. The peak of production occurs between November and January.
