We are in Araponga in the Matas de Minas region, at an average altitude of 1250m, we are the 4th generation, we work with family farming, artisan agriculture, without pesticides, focused on social, economic, and environmental sustainability, with regenerative practices. The springs are all fenced, there is riparian forest, the management of the plantation is through pruning and grazing, the coffee straw returns to the plantation as fertilizer, the native trees that grow in the middle of the coffee plantations are maintained and repel pests, avoiding the incidence of disease.



The estate's coffees are single-origin, striking notes, clean, delicate balance between acidity and sweetness, and long, pleasurable finishes. As a result of much love, dedication and commitment, Jardim das Oliveiras coffee is among the best coffees in Brazil in the most varied competitions.

Marked by the predominance of family farmers, the Matas de Minas region proves that agriculture taken seriously can bring great transformations and improvements to a region. For a time, this area was seen as limited and unable to produce high quality coffee, this

reality has been reversed with the creation of coffee quality contests created in the region.

We work with 100% Arabica coffee of the varieties: Red Catuaí Red Catiguá Yellow Catiguá Yellow Bourbon Oeiras Aranans

We combine the knowledge of our ancestors with the insertion of new technologies to increase quality and productivity without harming the environment. We use the by-product of coffee processing as a nutritional source for the coffee plantation, and we don't use pesticides. With these practices we make possible a balance between human activity and nature, increasing biodiversity and the natural fight against diseases by natural predators and improving crop pollination. We have distinct varieties to please the most diverse palates.
