PRODUCTS



Our propolis is exclusively natural from the Brazilian mangrove areas, it is a compound rich in polyphenols and flavonoids, whose synergistic action offers a variety of benefits. Our honeys on the other hand, also have their particularities, they are from different biomes, for example, we have mangrove honey, which is produced in the mangrove area, that of the Atlantic Forest that we have in our region a wealth of flora and The Honey of the Caatinga that as the name says, comes from the sertão region.

Caatinga Blossom, Atlantic Forest Blossom, Mangrove Blossom and Red Propolis Extract.

The Federal Inspection Service, known worldwide by the acronym S. I. F. and linked to the Department of inspection of Animal products – DIPOA, is responsible for ensuring the quality of edible and inedible animal products destined for the domestic and foreign markets, as well as imported products. Currently, SIF operates in more than 5 thousand Brazilian establishments, all under the supervision of DIPOA.

Honey is produced from the nectar of flowers, so its density, aroma and taste depend on the flowering visited by bees.

DETAILS ON PRODUCTION CAPACITY, SEASONALITY AND OTHER CHARACTERISTICS:



Currently our production capacity reaches 800kg per year of honey from the Atlantic Forest, between the periods of August to April, 800kg per year of honey from the mangrove, between the periods of August to April and 1 ton per year of honey from the Caatinga throughout the year.
