Our product is obtained by harvesting the ripe seeds of the guaraná tree (*Paullinia Cupana*). These seeds have energizing and antioxidant properties that make them extremely coveted by the food industry. The product delivered has a moisture content of less than 10%, a caffeine content of more than 3.5% and a reddish-brown visual appearance, with organoleptic characteristics that meet quality standards.

Our company proudly sells products from the Karina and Jacarandá farms, allowing us to guarantee uniformity throughout the process. All the organic guarana we supply is fertilized, harvested, stripped, washed, dried, ventilated and bagged under our management. This careful approach not only preserves the authenticity of the product, but also ensures superior quality standards in every batch. Choosing our guarana means opting for a unique experience, backed by decades of dedication to excellence and customer satisfaction.
