GRAVETERO's flagship products are sweets made from a succulent fruit known as an umbu (Brazil Plumb), rich in vitamins and minerals.

ORGANIC UMBU JAM - 630g

59% whole, eco-extractive umbu fruit, with a soft texture and delightfully tart.

SLICED ORGANIC UMBU SWEETS - 300g

Environmentally-friendly fruit extract. Tangy, with a firm texture and darkly colored.

ORGANIC UMBU SWEETS - 230g

Environmentally-friendly fruit extract. Soft texture with a rich color and sweet-sour taste.

ORGANIC GOIABA (GUAVA) SWEETS - 230g

Crushed fruit, with a creamy texture, pleasant flavor and vibrant color.

ORGANIC UMBU JELLY - 240g

Eco-friendly, dark, shiny and tangy fruit.

Fruits from agroecological farming. Clear, bright and a low level of acidity.

Coopercuc functions as the key market strategist focused on adding value to Caatinga products, particularly through promoting the Caatinga umbu and passion fruit. There are a number of products in their product line that support this philosophy.
